Objectives

- Students will learn about different bugs that live in soil: worms, beetles, grubs
- Students will have the opportunity to engage in structured play, adult modeling, and sensory exploration

- Do bugs help the springtime plants grow?
- Can you crawl like a bug or wiggle like a worm?
